



SUGGESTIONS FOR TIGER CUB ADVANCEMENT

Welcome to Tiger Cubs! In Tiger Cubs you will be working with your adult partner to have fun and earn advancements toward your Tiger Cub Badge.

To earn your Tiger Cub Badge, you will need to do these things:

1. Earn your Totem. This is really easy and you will probably earn it in the first few den meetings. Your Totem will be presented at a pack meeting with all the other Cub Scouts.
2. Complete the 15 requirements for the Tiger Cub Badge with your adult partner. These requirements are divided into 5 Family Activities, 5 Den Activities, and 5 Go See Its. For each requirement you complete, you will get a bead that goes on your Totem. You will get white beads for Family Activities, orange beads for Den Activities, and black beads for Go See Its. The beads will also be presented at pack meetings.
3. When you have completed all 15 requirements, you will get your Tiger Cub Badge at a pack meeting.
4. Activities that are completed at a den or pack meeting will be recorded on the meeting record sheet, they do not need to be turned in by your parent or guardian.
5. Activities that are completed outside den and pack meetings need to be turned in at a den meeting. Please don't try to turn them in at a pack meeting or outing, there is too much going on at these times. To turn in a requirement, write the Scout's name and the requirement on a sheet of paper and turn it in to the adult who is filling out the meeting record sheet. It will be recorded on the meeting record sheet, dated and signed or initialed, and returned to you.

There are 50 'elective' activities for Tiger Cubs. You will get one yellow Tiger Track bead for each 10 elective requirements completed and turned in. You can get credit for the same elective more than one time, but try not to be too repetitive. You can work on electives any time, but we cannot present yellow elective beads until you have earned your Tiger Cub Badge.

After you have earned your Tiger Cub Badge, you can try to earn your Bobcat Badge if you want to. To earn your Bobcat Badge, you have to have your Tiger Cub Badge first. You really don't have to earn this badge until you are a Wolf Cub Scout.

Academics & Sports Program--You can earn Academics & Sports Belt Loops and Pins at any time while you are a Cub Scout (regardless of rank), don't concentrate on them while you are a Tiger Cub. You may earn some at den or pack meetings or outings, but the achievements and electives in the Tiger Cub Handbook are more appropriate for this age and skill level.
